The sister online, open access journal to the European Journal of Law and Technology - the Web Journal of Current Legal Issues - has traditionally been a journal which published articles related to common law issues. We intend to move towards a more European focus to the journal in future and invite the readership of EJLT to consider us for submission of articles. Articles which deal with pan-Europe issues and which take a relatively esoteric field of law and put this into a context for a wider readership are particularly welcome. We also welcome comments on European case law as viewed from different jurisdictions, and case law from European jurisdictions.

The Web JCLI is the oldest eJournal in Europe (being a few months older than EJLT). It enables authors to reach a readership around the world without the cost barriers of commercial publishing. Authors, importantly, retain their copyright to their work. We believe that - like the EJLT - we attain the gold standard of 'open access'.
